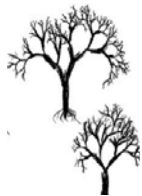
ATTENTION MEN: A Bible Study-Fellowship time is held on Thursdays at 7:00 p.m. at the home of David Faris. All men welcome!!!
